### **3R Good Practice**

- **Bio-Medical Waste disposal project**

This organisation in Gujarat is involved in collecting medical waste from various hospitals in and around Porbandar city thrice a week on alternate days here. Members of the Manav Seva Trust collect medical waste from 180 hospitals spread over an area of 100 kilometres with the help of its covered vans. The waste is disposed in an electric furnace on every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

The waste is disposed off as per the guidelines set by the State Environment Ministry at an incinerator built by the Trust in the suburb of Porbandar.
