## OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

### **Introduction**

Green Star scrap batteries volunteer service teams was founded in 2001, headed by Wang rehabilitation. The objective of the organization is to solve the fundamental problem of scrap battery.

### **Activity**

- Awareness through brochures and hotline
- Conducting survey on battery consumption and waste battery recycling

In early 2003, this service team has produced 10,000 sets of universal knowledge of the battery brochures and distributed to the community. Simultaneously, the same information was provided via hotline. In October 2003, the teams organized more than 600 volunteers to carry out the survey on battery consumption and waste battery recycling. In August 2005, the teams and the University of West Los Angeles jointly implemented a project, entitled "A Green Beijing, Scrap Batteries Pilot Project". Currently, teams with North China Branch of China Petroleum and other 400 units established a cooperative relationship in order to increase recycling of waste battery.

### **Outcomes of the practice**

- Prevention of potential harm to the ecological environment brought about by disposing of scrap batteries and conservation of precious resources through education.
- Increased public awareness and effective management of scrap battery.
