OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

Introduction

The Association for Collecting and Recycling Resources comprises of recycling-oriented companies such as paper manufacturers and citizens. With the objective of literally "collecting and recycling" resources including milk cartons, the organization is engaged in the coordination of a wide range of projects, such as establishing a recycling channels and developing recycling-related equipment, machinery and products. It is also involved with the management of the Recycled Milk Carton Mark (Pack Mark) project.

Activity

- Building a school-based mechanism for recycling milk cartons
- Planning to publish a book and hold a symposium

The association installed boxes for collection of milk cartons at elementary schools. As part of the Japan Fund for the Global Environment Grants Program, the organization plans to make a booklet introducing cases of recycling "other paper-made containers and packaging (other paper containers)" and hold a symposium.
