OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

Introduction

Global Environment Centre (GEC) was established as a non-profit organization in 1998 to work on environment issues of global importance. GEC supports information exchange and capacity building as well as undertaking strategic projects particularly in developing countries. It works in partnership with other like-minded agencies worldwide.

Activity

- Awareness and capacity building program on 3Rs practice

The Global Environment Centre (GEC) teamed up with Kuala Lumpur City Hall to create awareness of environment conservation and to promote environmentally friendly habits among the community in Taman Tun Dr Ismail (TTDI). The project chose TTDI Ramadan bazaar to cut plastic and styrofoam usage. Shoppers were initiated to bring their own containers and bags for carrying their shopping in order to reduce municipal solid waste. Garden International School (GIS) began their SMART Ranger training with GEC and since then they organized numerous projects within the school to raise awareness about waste and recycling.

Outcome

The canteen at Garden International School (GIS) stopped using styrofoam containers.
