OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

Introduction

The National Council of Women's Organizations (NCWO) is the consultative and advisory body for women's organizations affiliated to it.

Activity

- Commencing buy-back recycling community centre project
- Awareness on the benefits of recycling

The National Council of Women's Organization (NCWO) initiated buy-back recycling community centre project and paid three sen per kg for mixed glass, five sen per kg for mixed paper, 10 sen per kg for mixed plastics, 15 sen per kg for old newspaper and magazines and RM 1 per kg for crushed aluminium drink cans. In co-operation with Alam Flora and the Petaling Jaya Municipal Council (MPPJ), NCWO continued similar buy-back days from 10am to 1pm every third Saturday for each month. Besides that, it encourages the public to stop using plastic bags and other disposable items made of non-biodegradable materials and supermarkets and shopping centers to give out paper bags instead. It also urges the Government in order to phase out the production and use of non-biodegradable plastics.
