## OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

### Introduction

Treat Every Environment Special Sdn Bhd (TrEES) is a small grassroots organization, founded in February 1995. The objective of this organization is to help re-connect the urban community with the environment.

### Activity

- Waste awareness and recycling program

Based on the funding received from Danish International Development Agency (DANIDA), TrEES initiated a project on waste awareness and recycling program. The organization coupled education of the community with facilities to practice recycling. DANIDA provided support for infrastructure and the education materials to set up the community recycling centers. TrEES has developed 11 recycling centers located strategically throughout Kuala Lumpur. Seven of the TrEES centers, which act as community drop-off points for recyclable waste, are at welfare homes while the other four are at retail shops and supermarkets. Items accepted include glass bottles, aluminium and steel cans, wearable old clothes and all kinds of paper.
