OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

Introduction

Prayas Nepal is an NGO, which encourages involvement of women in Nepal's sustainable development. It is known as a productive and service-oriented program for being environmentally conscious and self-dependent. It was established in 2052 B.S. by some local Nepali women striving for the betterment of the society. The effort began by garbage removal and community composting in ward 4 of Baluwatar, Kathmandu.

3R Good Practices

Prayas Nepal involves communities to efficiently recover resources out of solid waste. It creates awareness on the importance of paper recycling and producing handmade recycled paper and product to consumers. It also provides technical support and training to produce compost from organic waste and supports with funding for compost bins that is distributed to the community for composting.

Outcome of Practices

Initiation of Prayas Nepal has been successful involving local women community. These women started to manage solid waste from their own households and later slowly influenced their neighbors to carry out this activity. Thus, the solid waste management problem in this area is completely solved especially in ward 4 of the area. Hence, Prayas Nepal has turned out to be a good example and source of motivation for other community to carry out solid waste management in their area.
