OVERVIEW OF PRACTICES

Introduction

Jamarko is a cottage industry established in 2001, who is involved in community-based activities on paper waste recycling. The aim of this industry is to create a safe environment and provide employment opportunities to the underprivileged people in Nepal through paper recycling. It is engaged in emphasizing the importance of paper recycling and producing handmade recycled paper and products to the citizens.

3R Good Practice

The main activity of Jamarko is focused on minimizing paper waste generation by creating awareness among the citizens. About 55 tons of waste paper per year is handled by this industry. The present production level is expected to rise 5 to 7 times assuming the increase in the use of recycled paper in future. Apart from producing paper, the industry produces traditional Nepali Lokta paper products and lampshades on demand.

Outcome of Practice

The handmade recycled paper and products being attractive and environment-friendly, the industry has attracted many regular visitors including researchers from different countries who has appreciated the use these recycled products. It has also motivated young generation of Nepal to use recycled paper products. It has created employment opportunity and increase the awareness in the region.
